**EXAMPLE OF UTILITY SAVINGS BY INSTALLING 350-G WASHERS OVER 200-G WASHERS:**

**Average Water Saving by installing 350G Washers over 200G Washers: 36%**

If you have \$1,500.00 per month in water and sewer charges, and you install 350-G washers, the yearly savings would be approximately:

**Yearly Savings: \$6,300.00**

If you have \$1,800.00 per month in natural gas charges, and you install 350-G washers, the yearly savings would be approximately:

**Yearly Savings: \$3,800.00**

**Combined Gas & Electric Yealy Savings: \$10,100.00**

**Combined Monthly Savings: \$840.00**

**25 Year Life of Equipment Savings: \$252,500.00**

**OBSERVATION SUMMARY:**

- 1) Only the ADC washers come with factory standard tops and sides in Stainless Steel, an important feature for longevity of washers.
- 2) Conti-G is heavier in all three models that are compared.
- 3) Both ADC and Conti-G use significantly less water than Dexter. See the above examples.
- 4) The ADC and Conti-G are "soft-mount" washers. They can even be mounted on second story wood floors. Easier installation.
- 5) The Dexter needs to be bolted to a minimum 6 inch thick concrete floor, requiring expensive floor modification and installation costs.
- 6) Dexter washers and ADC washers both use a round door, which is considered more attractive by many end users and owners.
- 7) ADC and Conti-G can be easily moved for any major rear access repair. Dexter is bolted to the floor.
- 8) ADC and Dexter washers have easier operating controls. Conti-G requires more training of the customers in machine operation.
